In my closing let me share this...1 Corinthians 13:1 (KJV):

 **Meaning in Context:**

- *Charity* here means **love** (selfless, unconditional, God-centered love).
- Paul is teaching that no matter how gifted, talented, or successful we are — even if we can speak with great wisdom or spiritual power — if we don’t have love, it’s empty noise, like a loud gong or tinkling cymbal.
- It reminds us that **love must be the foundation** in faith, relationships, and even business.

 **Application for Life & Business:**

- Success without love is just noise.
- Communication without love is hollow.

Achievements without love lack eternal value.

Together, aligned with faith, they create harmony, impact, and legacy. We can have a true success story.”
